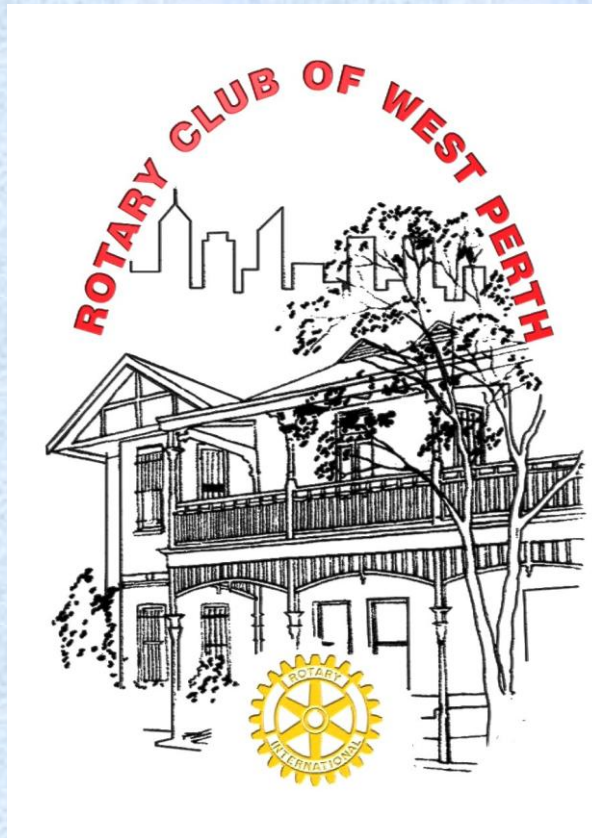

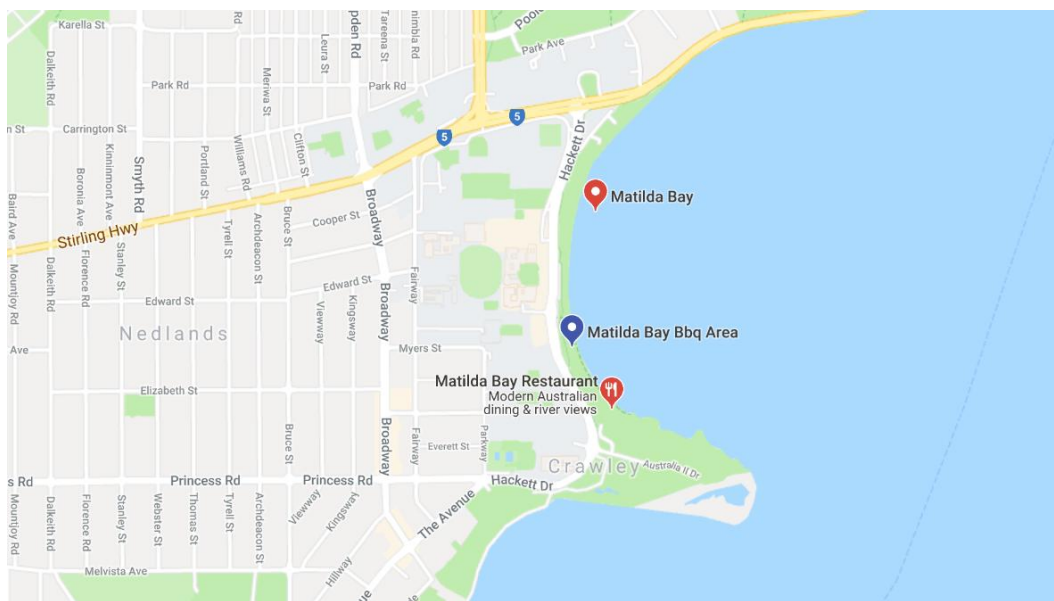
Our next planned event will be a relaxed evening picnic for all members, their families and friends. Another great opportunity for a Partner's catch up. All Welcome!
