**Speaker – Ms Ann Pickard, Chair of Shell Australia Ltd.**

Ann opened by stating that she is not keen on FIFO, which is the practice of flying workers in and out of worksites to segregated quarters which often angers rural and local communities. Ann believes it would be better if employees were part of the community. In March 2010, Ann took up the positions she currently holds after five years as EVP for Sub Saharan Africa based in Lagos, Nigeria. She managed to take Nigeria from having the worst safety record to Shell's best through her 12 life-saving rules, considered the best in the industry. Ann presented her core objectives which include, working together and planning for the future with Shell's partners – to make Shell the top LNG producer in the world. Planning for many oil and gas projects takes 30 or more years however, she is gratified by the future for gas in replacing coal –fired power plants, reducing carbon dioxide emissions by as much as 70%.

In order to help make this happen, there needs to be planning for skilled people, more local suppliers at competitive rates and more infrastructure from government.

Ann also wants to ensure more listening to the concerns of industry, government and all stakeholders so there are no surprises. To help make this happen, Shell needs a highly skilled workforce and Shell is collaborating with WA Training providers to increase the supply of skilled employees and is seeking more women and indigenous employees.
